### **CIRCULAR**

This is for information of all the employers of Nurses, Midwives, ANM, and MPHW that the Registration and renewal of registration of all the nurses working in the state of Delhi is mandatory vide Delhi Nursing Council Act 1997 section 17 and section 21

For Registration (Section-17) "Persons not registered not to practise or be employed as nurses etc.-No person other than a person registered under this Act shall practise directly or by implication as practising habitually or for personal gains as a nurse."

For Renewal (Section-21) "Every person registered" under this Act who intends to practice anywhere in the NCT of Delhi as a nurse, auxiliary nurse-midwife, female health worker, female health assistant/health supervisor, shall give notice in writing to the licensing authority in the month of January and every five years thereafter during the period if he continues to practise within the said area"

As per guidelines for renewal of registration the applicant must obtain credit hours by attending professional Continue Nursing Education (CNE). A Nurse must earn 30 credit hours in a year, accumulated to 150 credit hours over a period of 5 years which are required for renewal of DNC registration every 5 years.

All employers are suggested to develop CNE cell in your institute from upgrading knowledge and nursing skills enabling nurses to provide quality patient care and meet the criteria for renewal of their registration at Delhi Nursing Council. All CNE program shall be approved by the Delhi Nursing Council for more details visit Delhi Nursing Council website://www.delhinursingcouncil.com/CNEcreditHoursDetails.

It is requested to all the employers of nursing institutions to ensure that all the nurses working in their organisation/institution are registered and renewed their registration with Delhi Nursing Council. Failing which action will be initiated vide sub section (1) of section 26 Delhi Nursing Council Act.

Furthermore, all employers are also requested for online verification of RNRM, ANM before appointing them from DNC website and make a record for it.
