Minutes of the Principal's Meeting

A Meeting was convened in the Park Hotel, Sansad Marg, Connaught Place, New Delhi 110001 on 20th July 2023 at 4:00 pm with the principals of ANM, GNM and B.Sc. Nursing programme to discuss the agenda given below.List of members present are as per Annexure A. The meeting was conducted after the Nursing Seminar organised by Wolters Kluwer Publishers.

Mrs. Anjana Dhall, President, Delhi Nursing Council & Chairperson for the meeting welcomed the members and present the agenda.

Agenda No.1: Eligibility criteria for admission in ANM & GNM Programme.

In order to maintain uniformity in the admission of General Nursing & Midwifery and Auxiliary Nurse& Midwife programme in the state of Delhi, it is unanimously decided to continue the prescribed admission policy circulated earlier. However reiterated the same as under.

Admission criteria in GNM programme

- Eligibility criteria laid down by the Indian Nursing Council in the "syllabus and regulation of Diploma in General Nursing & Midwifery" revised 2015 of page 24 is to be followed as it is. There is no upper age limit.
- Additional guidelines formulated in Principal's meeting are as follows:-
 - List of the subjects to be considered for admission are given below. Any best four subjects from the list given below are to be considered for calculation of aggregate percentage.

List of Subjects:-

- (a) Physics
- (b) Chemistry
- (c) Biology
- (d) Mathematics

- (e) Commerce (f) Accountancy
- (g) Economics
- (h) Business Studies
- (i) Computer Science/Informatics Practice/Ward Processing/Multimedia
- (i) History
- (k) Geography (l) Civics
- (m) Sociology
- (n) Psychology (o) Political Science (p) Home Science
- (q) English
- 3. The candidate must have passed English at 10+2 level by the concerned examination board/qualifying board.

Admission criteria in ANM programme

- The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December of the year in which admission is sought. There is no upper age limit.
- The maximum age for admission shall be 35 years.
- The minimum educational requirements shall be 10 + 2 in Arts (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Biotechnology, Economics, Political Science, History, Geography, Business Studies, Accountancy, Home Science, Sociology, Psychology, and Philosophy) and English Core/English Elective or Science or Health care Science Vocational stream ONLY passing out from recognized Board.
- Students qualified in 10+2 Arts or Science examination conducted by National Institute of Open School.
- Student shall be medically fit.
- Student shall be admitted once in a year.

Note 1:-The list of admitted candidates must reach Delhi Nursing Council on stipulated date in the soft and hard copy in the following format given below:

Note 2: Calendar of events, vacation and other events must be followed as issued by Delhi Nursing Council.

Note 3: The principals are directed to strictly adhere to the instructions.

Agenda No. 2: Examination Guidelines (ANM & GNM)

- 1. Shall have one regular examination followed by supplementary examination in academic year
- 2. The candidates if fail in more than two subjects in any nursing programme they can be promoted to next year. However all papers need to be cleared before appearing in the final examination.
- 3. A candidate can take any number of attempts with a condition that the concerned verify the eligibility stating that the student who complete prescribed number of hours of theory as well as practical and other condition.
- 4. The maximum period to complete ANM /GNM is the double the duration of course ie. 4 years for ANM and 6 years for GNM.

5. No institution shall submit student average internal marks more than 75% i.e., if 40 students are admitted in a course than the average score of the 40 students shall not exceed 75%.

Example of 5 students: A= 25, B= 20, C=22, E=24 Average score = 89.6%

Agenda No. 3. Others

- The Chairperson has taken a serious note on refusal to conduct practical examination and evaluation of theory papers. The name of the faculty who refuses to do their academic activities will be forwarded to their respective management.
- If, any candidate left the course, the intimation should reach to the Delhi Nursing Council on same day/earliest.
- In case of online transfer of examination fees the screenshot of the same may be the email to the Delhi Nursing Council on the same day.
- The list of faculty teaching the subject for last 3 years must be send to DNC by 31st March every year
- Principals may guide the passed out students to register in Delhi Nursing Council online portal for RN/RM number immediately after the declaration of results.
- Principals are responsible to clarify doubts of students and discourage students to visit DNC office.
